Apply for multistate license at <https://apps.wv.gov/Nursing/OnlineRegistration/> beginning November 30, 2017

Self-enroll into Nursys e-Notify for free & Keep up-to-date with your license(s). You can receive licensure status updates, track license verifications for endorsement and create and manage multiple license expiration reminders. Enroll at [Nursys e-Notify](#) and select "As a Nurse" to complete the registration process.

- You may pay for your background checks when you register.
- State and federal background checks are now all electronic. It will take 2 – 3 business days for the West Virginia Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses to receive the results.

- Has no misdemeanor convictions related to the practice of nursing
- Is not currently a participant in an alternative program
- Has a valid US social security number
