**1. CALL TO ORDER**

### **6. PUBLIC SESSION FOR MOTIONS RELATED TO MATTERS DISCUSSED DURING EXECUTIVE SESSION FOR**

#### **A. K. HILL MULTISTATE PRIVILEGE #2019-1**

Teresa Ritchie made a motion that the Board adopt the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Hearing Examiner with the following modifications regarding the license for Multistate Privilege #2019-1, issued to K. Hill:

The Board ORDERS that the privilege to practice registered professional nursing in the state of West Virginia granted to Kyle Hill shall remain suspended. The Board further ORDERS that Kyle Hill shall NOT be given the privilege to practice in the state of West Virginia. After at least one year from the date of this ORDER Hill may submit an endorsement application for a single state license to the Board for review and present proof that he has complied with all requirements of the Virginia Board of Nursing and he has an unencumbered nursing license in the state of Virginia.

Nancy Atkins offered the second. The motion carried.

## **7. REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION OF PRIVACY POLICY OF THE AGENCY**

The Board reviewed the Privacy Policy for the Agency. Nancy Atkins made a motion to reaffirm the Privacy Policy. Theresa Dennison offered the second. The motion carried.
