

## Board QI plan standard with key quality indicators reference

Any NCLEX-RN program who did not meet key quality indicators (national nursing accredited, Board full approval, no major organizational change, 3 or less directors in 5 years, less than 50% direct care, less than 35% FT faculty, less than 70% graduation rate, program younger than 7 years, RN program director with less than a doctoral degree, RN program faculty with less than a graduate degree) and Board standards for licensure pass rate (< 80%), graduation rate (< 70%), attrition rate (> 50%), or employment rate (< 80%) as reported on the NCLEX-RN annual report must submit a QI plan by the subsequent March 1.
