Doris Burkey made a motion that the practice committee recommends to the Board that staff draft a Board response that is reviewed and approved by the Board general counsel, from the Executive Director, with a cc to Board members, that the Board concurs with the definition of Palliative Care as listed in the WV Code 16-55-2 which states “ patient and family centered medical care that optimizes quality of life by anticipating, preventing and treating suffering caused by serious illness throughout the continuum of illness, involves addressing physical, emotional social and spiritual needs and facilitates patient autonomy, access to information and choice” and that this definition is consistent with the position statement issued by the Board in the Administration of Anesthetic Agents Position Statement revised June 2018 that an RN can provide ketamine for palliative care. Ann Bostic seconded. Motion Passed.
